## Notes from May's Board Meeting

- The BCS had been offered a workshop on measuring social impact via Power to Change. This prompted a useful review of what information we already have and highlighted that although we have data from the member's surveys, we have less understanding of other customers' views, so are planning to conduct a survey of pub, café & post office users across a full week in July.
- As part of the Power to Change options appraisal work, we have been looking at options to remodel the pub end to include a fire and revamp the toilets to include an accessible toilet. We discussed three main options provided by our architect and selected one to be worked up in more detail, which we aim to share with members in the near future.
- As previously reported a group of members had offered to review the business and they came to provide the feedback from that exercise. This proved a useful discussion, with a general message that to increase profitability there is no single issue, but a need for a more commercial focus across all activities, in particular in our approach to events.
- There has been a discussion over a number of months about the price of beer and after a thorough benchmarking exercise with Board members visiting all the local pubs, we agreed to a rise in the majority of beer prices.

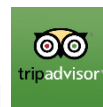
