Notes of BCS Directors' Meeting - Thurs Jan 14th 2016

Meeting held on Thursday January 14th 2016

The details of the AGM to be held on January 30th were finalised. It was noted that the deadline for resolutions to be submitted had passed without any submissions.

In light of the ongoing problems with the car parking in the Anglers car park, the policy has been reviewed with the conclusion that greater effort should be made to enforce the policy as it stands.

Notices will be erected to state that the parking is for customers and permit holders only. Permit holders are asked to park in the top car park. Parking in breach of these terms and conditions will attract a fine of £60 and steps will be taken to enforce the charge.

The operational report stated that we had served 229 Christmas meals with overwhelmingly excellent feedback. New Years Eve also proved to be a success with takings up from last year.

Following some of the observations about the pub and beer as detailed on the latest survey of members, the Directors agreed the need to solicit the views of non-members and to understand the beer buying policy.

The progress of the work on The Anglers formed a major item for discussion as problems with the roof structure continue to emerge. The architect attended for this item and the remedial work required and the consequent costs were discussed in detail.
