Update on the building work



Peak Park have responded to the pre-application questions and the main thing that they require full planning consent for are the solar panels, so we are able to proceed with most of the rest of the works. On the 28th September the architect, structural engineer and contractor were on site to undertake a number of intrusive surveys and much crawling around in the roof spaces. We are currently waiting analysis from the structural engineer and costs from the contractor to finalize the detail and approach to some elements of the project, but work should start in mid-October.
